



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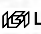
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Diagram of an emerald cut diamond showing proportions: Table 14%, Depth 50.5%, Length 63%, Width 69.1%, and a Medium cut quality.
