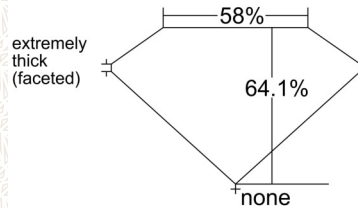

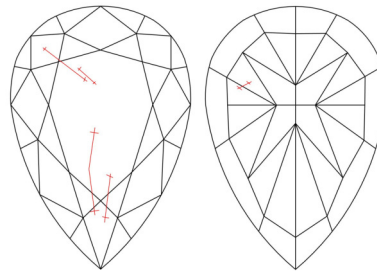


Illustration of GIA fancy color
