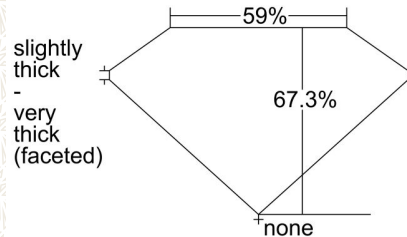

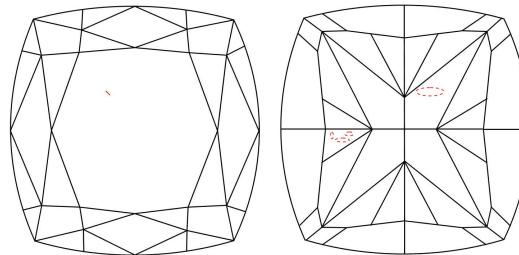


Illustration of GIA fancy color grade interrelationships
