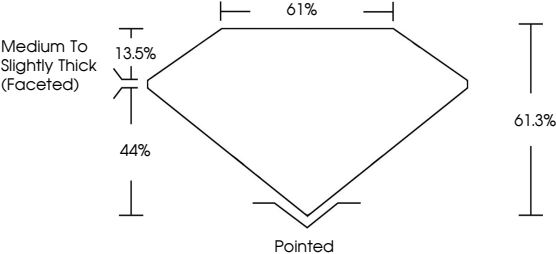

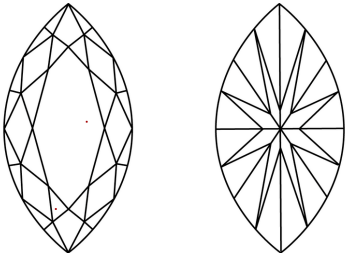


Medium To Slightly Thick (Faceted)

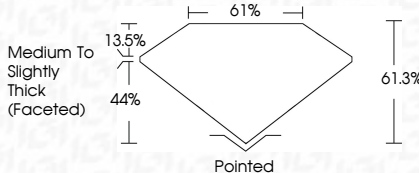
