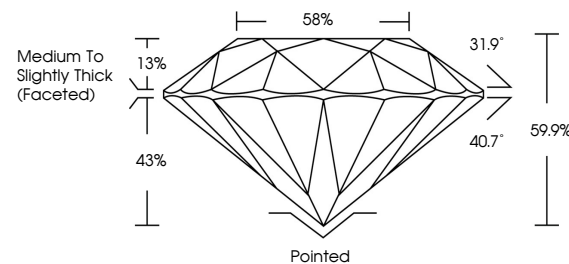

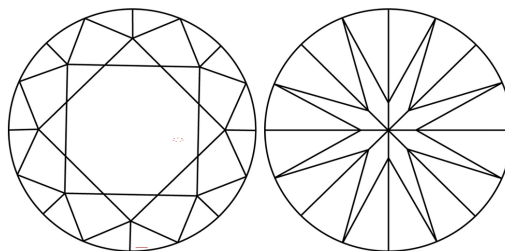

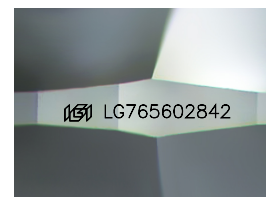


CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

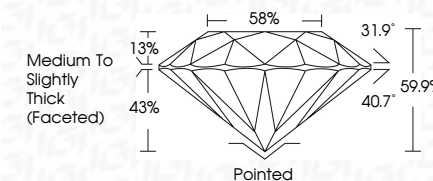
