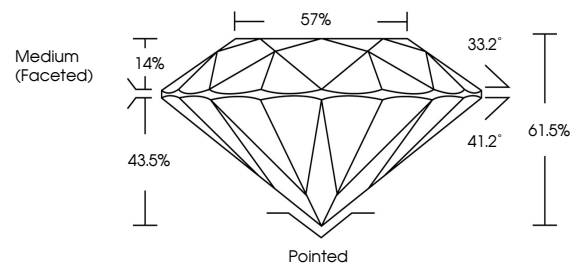

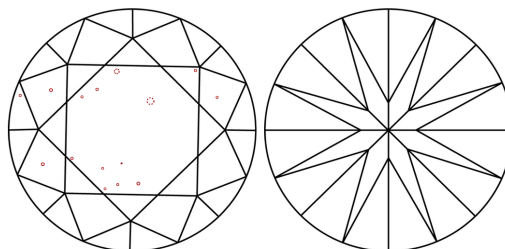

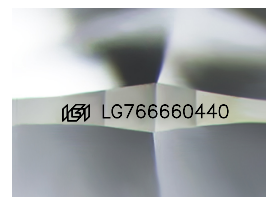


CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

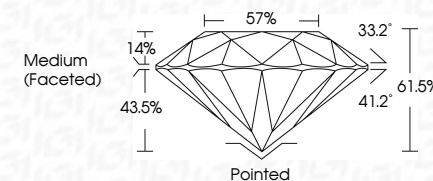
