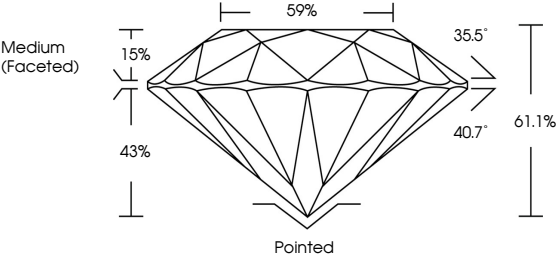

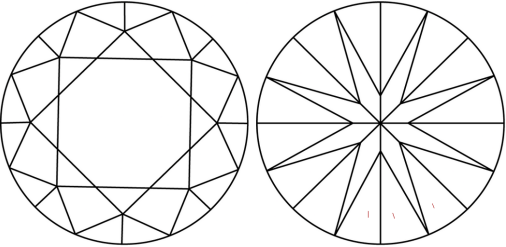

CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

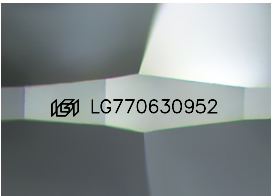
