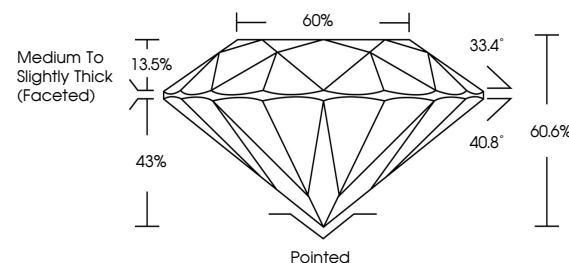

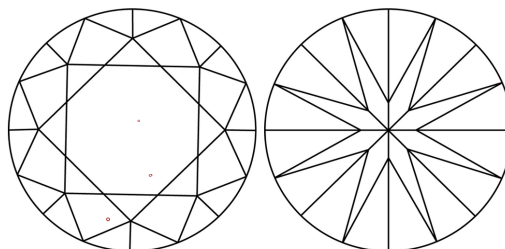

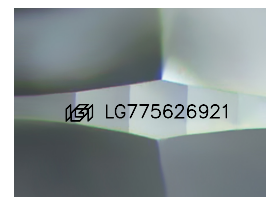


CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

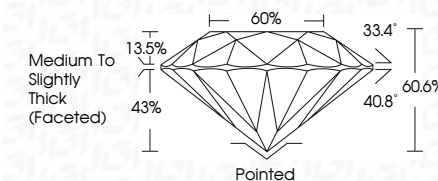
