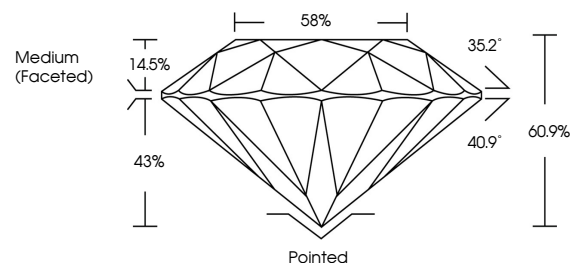

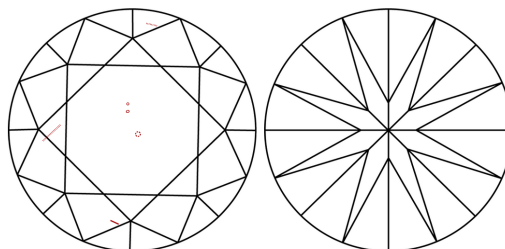

CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

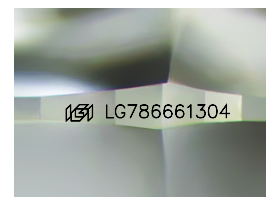

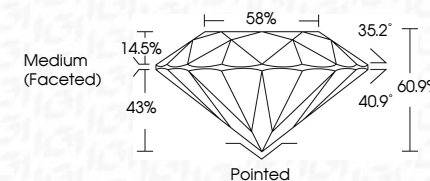
