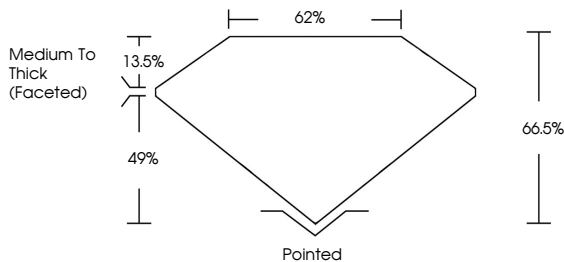

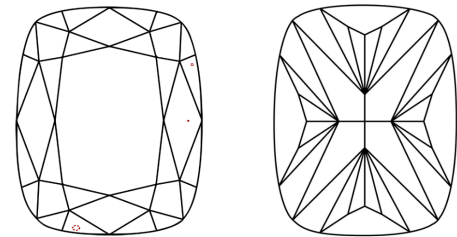

CLARITY CHARACTERISTICS

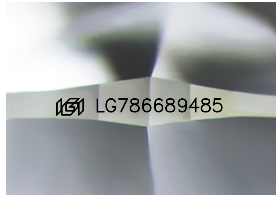
