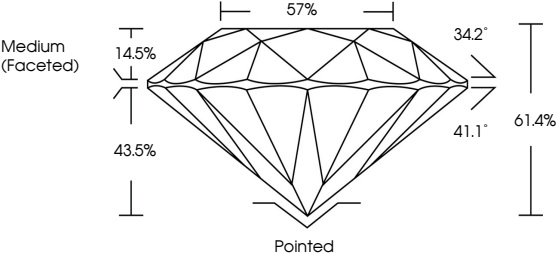

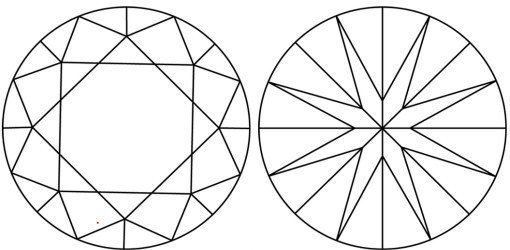

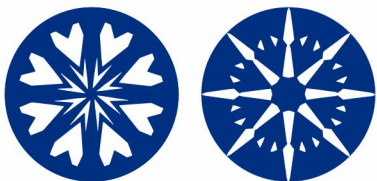
PROPORTIONS

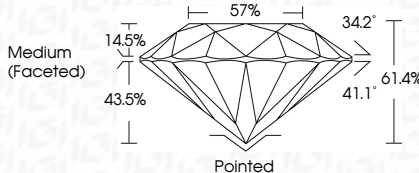
