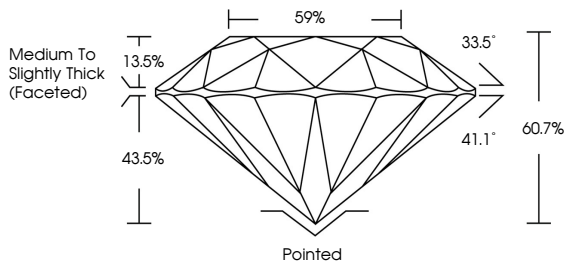

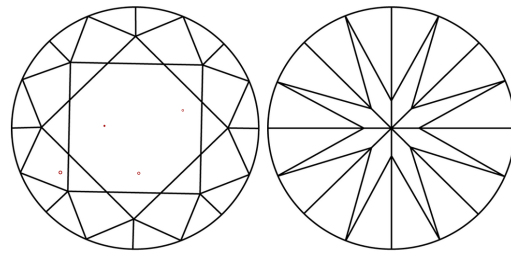


Diagram showing the clarity characteristics of the diamond, including internal and external features.
